

**MOS STEWARDSHIP COMMITTEE MEETING
MAY 19, 2014**

Meeting Purpose:

- Develop list of potential new team members and who will contact them.
- Discuss and sign up for Parish Info/Welcome Tent at Festival.
- Discuss next 'session' from September-June.
- Appoint a new chair/co-chairs for the team.

Updates:

- Mass times will be changing, starting July 5th. The 9:30 am and 11:00 am masses will merge into two masses, 8am and at 10 am. This will be a permanent change.
- MOS Festival will be held June 5, 5-10pm and Jun 6 & 7th, 5–11pm. The festival will be set up in the church parking lot. There will be some changes this year, such as, food trucks and live music. Also, due to the change, parking will be a challenge.

Projects 2014:

- Stewardship Committee will have a tent set up at the festival. Still working out details, but hope to have access to electricity so we can show a video. Will also have brochures, and possibly rosaries available. Need members to sign-up for times to man the booth. We need to show our presence. Tom distributed a sign up sheet and asked for help in getting this filled.
- Jonathan and Tom will be leaving the committee in June. Our last meeting together will be in June (date to be determined based on Father Paul's schedule). Need to appoint a new chair. Tom stated that there is one person who may step in as chair, but that is not yet confirmed. Distributed a list and asked for everyone's help in providing names for a potential chairperson and additional committee members. If anyone thinks of additional names, please let Tom know.
- Need to come up with ideas for engagement efforts. Ideas for future events, a blog, Facebook, etc. Any thoughts on how we can get information to our parishioners and the general public. Some ideas were discussed:
 - Partner with the Liturgy Committee to do a healing mass or a Thanksgiving mass.
 - St. Joseph's table. (This may require a St. Joseph's table committee).
 - Get more youth involved. What would interest our younger parishioners? Matt suggested we get together with a group of young parishioners and ask them what they would like to see.
 - Have a large screen display for the church to use during mass. Have youth sign up to operate the screen. Would need to develop content for the screen display, such as, announcements, messages, music, etc. Although everyone agreed that this is a great idea, we need to 'do our homework' as to the cost, complexity, etc., before committing to this. It may take a year to put it together. Jon has already begun benchmarking other parishioners that currently have large screens to see how they manage it. Fr. Paul suggested looking at St. Leo's, St. Mary's in the city and Assumption in Fairport.
 - Fr. Paul suggested that the 2014-2015 focus of the Stewardship team be two fold;
 - Support the efforts of the Digital Ministry team to deliver & staff a projection screen mass experience that is **sustainable without any gaps in content or staffing**, analogous to the development, roll-out, and ongoing maintenance of the new website.
 - Partner with the Liturgy Committee in non-digital outreach activities
